To clarify questions posed by the City Council, Director Enriquez provided a status update on the Fish Canyon Trail Restoration project.

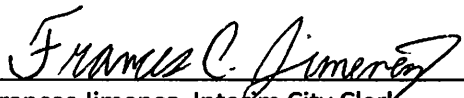
